- Application forms must be returned to Dundalk Credit Union by 16th September 2020.
- The Bursaries will be allocated by an Open Draw.
- Payments will be made in two instalments or at the discretion of Dundalk Credit Union.
- Payment of the Bursary is dependent on the student continuing their course in a Third Level Institution for the duration of the academic year, and the production of satisfactory evidence to that effect.
- Applicants/winners must be members of Dundalk Credit Union for the duration of the academic year.
